The Implementing Agreement for Co-operation on Technologies and Programmes for Demand-Side Management (“DSM IA”) has requested an extension for the period 1 March 2016 to 28 February 2019.


In accordance with the procedures established by the IEA Committee on Energy Research and Technology (“CERT”) at its meeting held 3-4 March 2010, the DSM IA submitted the CERT Criteria for Implementing Agreement Requests for Extension, the End-of-Term Report and the Strategic Plan (the “Supporting Documents”).

At its meeting held 10-12 September 2014, the Working Party on Energy End-Use Technologies (“EUWP”) reviewed the revised Strategic Plan and carried out an evaluation. The EUWP forwarded the results of the evaluation to the CERT, recommending that the CERT approve the request for extension of the DSM IA for the period 1 March 2016 to 28 February 2019.

By written procedure ending 13 November 2014, the CERT reviewed the EUWP evaluation and recommendation. At its meeting held 18-19 November 2014, the CERT approved the extension of the Implementing Agreement for Co-operation on Technologies and Programmes for Demand-Side Management for the period 1 March 2016 to 28 February 2019.
