Dear Mr. Kool,


The IEA Committee on Energy Research and Technology (CERT) reviewed the supporting documents (the CERT Criteria for Implementing Agreement Requests for Extension, the End-of-Term Report and the Strategic Plan) and considered the recommendation of the Working Party on Energy End-Use Technologies (EUWP).

Based on these elements, at its meeting on 4-5 December 2013, the CERT approved the extension of the Implementing Agreement for Co-operation on Technologies and Programmes for Demand-Side Management from 1 March 2014 to 28 February 2016.

In addition, the CERT recommended that, should new information be made available that addresses the concerns expressed by the EUWP before 29 February 2016, that the EUWP consider an additional extension from 1 March 2016 to 29 February 2019 and to make a recommendation to the CERT.
