8. Discussion on possible osmosis from EC SAVE project, called “White and Green”, towards task 14 will be promoted. Possible interaction with the recently approved EC EIE project EuroWhiteCert will be considered as well, taking profit of the presence in it of Task experts.
9. CEN-CENELEC groups were established to get to a EU wide standard on Green, White and Black Certificates. Some of Task experts are in contact with these groups and are suggested to report about the works in progress.
10. Some presentations are planned from France, Italy and Sweden (Norway will be welcome), describing the most up-to-date situation about their Energy Efficiency policies, the relevant national targets, the state of their compliance and the establishment of a scheme for White Certificates issuing and trading
12. Comments of all the present experts will be solicited on the workshop held the day before, in view of pointing out the most remarkable aspects and the learned lesson in view of the next workshop. I remind that the report containing the Critical Synthesis of the relevant discussions will make up an official deliverable of the Task 14.
13. It is important to decide since now the dates for the next workshops, in order to allow all of us to get organised well in advance. France accepted to host the next workshop in April 2005: if France is able to organise it in the week between 11/4/05 and 15/4/05, we will have the chance to have the presence of David Crossley, the OA of task 15, who will be in Europe in that period for other meetings and will be able to present in detail the scheme of White Certificates adopted at present in New Wales - Australia (a very valuable contribution for the workshop and for the Task indeed!). Sweden is going to hold his workshop at Lund University on 16-17 June 2005.
