Dear Mario, Dear colleagues,

I regret to inform you that I cannot attend the CEN/Cnelec meeting in Milan next week. I am very interested in the issues linked to the evaluation and certification of energy savings. For us it is very interesting to establish common European methods to evaluate saving resulting from energy efficiency projects. A similar evaluation should also be established for CO2 emission reduction resulting from energy efficiency projects. Both IPMVP and the UNFCCC CDM board are also very active in this field.

As far as white certificates are concerned, we are also interested in the policy design issues (who should be obliged, market issues, etc.) , which I believe are topics more for policy makers than standardisation bodies.

We will follow a new EIE SAVE project (starting on 1/05) that will deal with both the above topics and the possible integration of white, green and brown certificates.

I would also recommend that for green certificates you will look at the RECS organisation operation and achievements ([www.recs.org](http://www.recs.org)) and the work of the Association of the Issuing Bodies.

Last but not least, I would like to inform you and the other colleagues that we will try to organise a European workshop on White Certificates in the first quarter of 2005 to bring all the experts, stakeholders, and policy makers together and have a full exchange of information.

Please kept me informed of the meeting results and do not hesitate to contact me if you would need further information.
